

Courses for College Credits

Portersville Christian School has been working in conjunction with Butler County Community College to offer English 101 and Communications 201 to our seniors, giving them the option to earn 6 college credits if they are eligible. Mrs. Wise has been credentialed to teach Sociology 211 and General Psychology 201. We will be offering these courses to our seniors next year. This will allow our students who are eligible to earn 12 college credits.

If a student has already applied and is signed up to take the English 101 class in the fall, the only action they will need to take is to register for the sociology course for the fall. This course does not require a student to test to join, but there is a requirement of a 3.0 GPA. If a student is close, please speak with Mrs. Wise to see if there is a possibility of a waiver.

The fall semester will be Sociology (period 2) and English 101 (period 7). Spring semester will be psychology and communications. We will be inviting our juniors to take the English and communications courses with the seniors. Their schedules do not allow them to take the sociology and psych courses next year. We are also inviting home schooled students to join us, and since this is a college class offered through BC3, any parents who might be interested in a few college classes may also consider this option.
