Attendance Policy Reminder

The following was taken from the handbook (pg 5):

To be eligible to participate in an Athletic Game/Fine Arts Performance or practice, a student must be in attendance the day of the event. This means being in homeroom by the 8:21 homeroom bell. This excludes any unavoidable delays such as bus/car breakdown, weather conditions, dentist or doctor appointments, etc.

In addition, a student must be in homeroom by the 8:21 homeroom bell on the morning after an Athletic Game/Fine Arts Performance to be eligible to participate in the next scheduled event. If a student is ill the day or days after an event and returns to school the day of the next scheduled event (according to the above policy), the said student may participate in that event provided an excuse from the parents indicates that the student was absent due to illness.
